Providing practical support for those planning, conducting or considering clinical, academic or management research is one of the core objectives of the [Trust Health Library and Information Service](#).

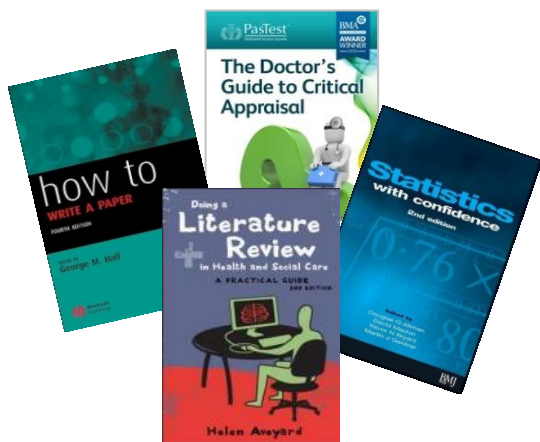
This leaflet outlines some of the services provided by the Library that are of particular relevance to researchers.

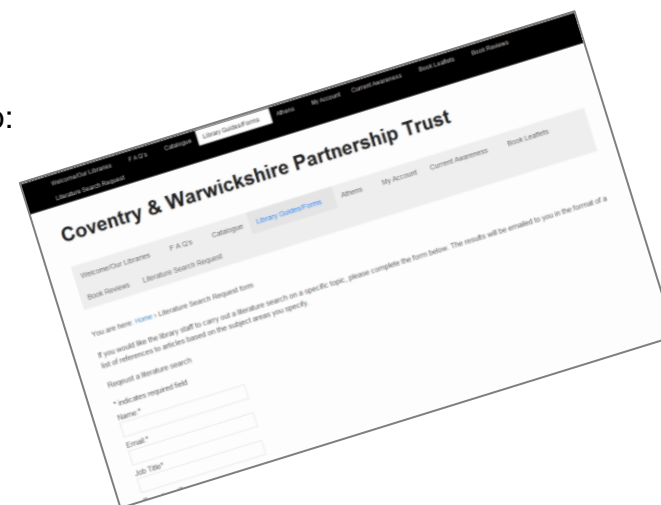
## Document Supply Service
